

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR VISITING MARES

Our aim at Bergen Stud is to breed performance horses. Mares with seriously poor confirmation or known hereditary diseases will not be accepted. Our Stud reserves all the right to refuse to accept any mare arriving in poor condition or deemed unfit for breeding.

SWABS: All mares must have a current clear CEM swab, satisfactory endometrial swab and cytology smear before arriving at Bergen Stud
EQUINE FLU AND TETANUS VACCINATIONS: All mares must have a valid certificate.

EQUINE HERPES VIRUS AND EQUINE VIRAL ARTHRITIS: Bergen Stud advises all mare owners to vaccinate their pregnant mares against Equine Herpes Virus whether stabled with other horses or not.

SHOES: It is requested that all mares be sent unshod, but with their feet freshly trimmed. Mares with very brittle feet may be shod in front by prior arrangement.

WORMING: All mares and foals will be wormed on arrival at Bergen Stud, and every six weeks thereafter. Owners will be charged for this.

INVOICING: Mare owners will be invoiced monthly, we ask for payment to be made within 7 days please.

FEES: Visiting mares and / or foals may not be removed until all fees and charges due to Bergen Stud are paid in full. If Bergen Stud gives notice that a visiting mare and / or foal should be removed from the premises for any reason whatsoever, and the owner shall fail to do so within a period of one month from the date of such notice, then Bergen Stud shall be entitled to sell the visiting mare and / or foal, and out of the proceeds of the sale defray the costs of the fees and any charges due, and the owner hereby appoints Bergen Stud its agent for the purpose of such sale.

KEEP OF MARES: Visiting mares will have the benefit of all the pasture available. Bergen Stud has the right to feed or stable grass kept mares and their foals if deemed in their interest, and owners will be charged accordingly. All mares and foals are sent at the owners risk and whilst every care is taken, Bergen Stud cannot accept any responsibility for accident, disease or illness however caused. Veterinary attention will be called in when necessary, to be paid for by the mare owner.
